Tampa Avenue and Droad Street road renaming

DATE:

October 4, 2021

Consistent with Chapter 745 of the Jacksonville Ordinance Code on addressing and street naming regulations, requests to rename streets require a review and recommendation from the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission. In making a report and recommendation, the Commission shall address the following criteria:

- 1. The origin of the street name
- 2. Any historical significance of the existing street name
- 3. Whether there are any historical structures or landmarks on the subject street
- 4. Whether the existing name is part of a common theme of street names throughout the community where such street is located
- 5. The age of the street name
- 6. Whether the street name is a duplicate street name

Current Street Name: Tampa Avenue

<u>Proposed Street Name</u>: Droad Street (extension)

# Reason for Change:

As a corrective action, the 911 Emergency Addressing Advisory Committee voted to move the Tampa Avenue road name, currently a paper right-of-way location, to the right-of-way to the immediate south, a field location with residences. The Droad Street road name would then continue across Rowe Avenue to the paper right-of-way.

## Analysis:

The road name relocation and change regarding Tampa Avenue and Droad Street provide a corrective action in order to ensure an accurate and effective public safety response for properties located on an un-named right-of-way. As a result, evaluation of the name change against the criteria found in Chapter 745 is not meaningful because the significance of the road name remains unchanged.

## Recommendation:

At the September 22, 2021 meeting of the Jacksonville Historic Preservation Commission (JHPC), the Planning and Development Department recommended that the proposed street name relocation of Tampa Avenue and name change from Tampa Avenue to Droad Street be approved by the Commission based on the best evidence available. The JHPC voted 4-0 to approve the name change.
