6 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING
7 AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) *ORDINANCE CODE*;
8 ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION AND
9 ASSOCIATED ROADWAY MARKERS FOR LIEUTENANT MARIO
10 J. MOYA, A FALLEN FIRE AND RESCUE OFFICER WHO
11 DIED WHILE IN THE LINE OF DUTY; ESTABLISHING AN
12 HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION ON RICKY DRIVE IN
13 COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 FOR LIEUTENANT MARIO J. MOYA;
14 PROVIDING FOR THE ROADSIDE MARKERS FOR
15 LIEUTENANT MARIO J. MOYA BE DEPICTED AS
16 CONTEMPLATED IN SECTION 745.105
17 (J) (9) (B); PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO
18 HONORARY ROADWAY MARKERS TO BE LOCATED IN
19 APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS ON THE DESIGNATED ROADWAY
20 IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6; WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105
21 (I) (2) WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE HONOREE BE
22 DECEASED FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS; WAIVER OF SECTION
23 745.105 (J) (10), ORD. CODE WHICH REQUIRES THAT
24 THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT SEND TWO
25 WRITTEN NOTIFICATIONS TO AFFECTED PROPERTY
26 OWNERS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES
27 DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE
28 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR
29 PROCESSING, IMPLEMENTATION, AND COORDINATION
30 WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC
31 ENGINEERING AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES AND

1 ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

3 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD)
4 submitted a request for an Honorary Street Name Designation to honor
5 Fire and Rescue Lieutenant Mario J. Moya; (Correspondence from the
6 Office of the Director/Fire Chief, City of Jacksonville Fire and
7 Rescue Department is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**); and

8 **WHEREAS**, Section 745.105 (j) (9) (b), Ord. Code, provides for
9 honorary designations for fallen fire and rescue officers who die
10 while in the Line of Duty; and

11 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with the criteria established pursuant
12 to Florida law, Lieutenant Mario J. Moya died while in the Line of
13 Duty; (The Florida Joint Council of Fire and Emergency Services
14 Firefighter Line-of-Duty Death Memorial Selection Process is attached
15 hereto as **Exhibit 2**); and

16 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Moya dedicated 17 years to the JFRD assigned as a
17 Firefighter to Rescue 42 on the B-shift, and was promoted up the
18 ranks to a Lieutenant position; and

19 **WHEREAS**, the Florida Joint Council of Fire and Emergency
20 Services will honor Lt. Moya's name on the Memorial Wall at the
21 Florida Fallen Firefighter Memorial in Ocala, Florida, and at the
22 State Capitol; (See attached **Exhibit 2**); and

23 **WHEREAS**, there will be additional events to recognize the memory
24 of Lt. Moya which include a "Ring of the Bell" ceremony, a "Last
25 Guard" ritual, presentation of a fallen firefighter memorial flag and
26 a medallion; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the Council finds that the accomplishments of
28 Lieutenant Mario J. Moya are worthy and deserving of a form of
29 recognition that the City of Jacksonville and Lieutenant Mario J.
30 Moya's family, friends and colleagues can share and celebrate in, to
31 wit: the creation of an honorary street designation and the

1 installation of two appropriate honorary roadway markers on Ricky
2 Drive in Council District 6; now therefore,

3 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 745.105(i)(3), Ord. Code, the
4 honoree lived in excess of 10 years in the community located within
5 5 miles of the location for the honorary designation; and

6 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

7 **Section 1. Ricky Drive to receive an honorary street**
8 **designation for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya.** Ricky Drive in Council
9 District 6 shall hereby be designated as contemplated by Section
10 745.105, *Ordinance Code*, for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya. A map of the
11 road designation is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

12 **Section 2. Honorary Roadside Markers for Lieutenant Mario**
13 **J. Moya to be depicted as authorized in Section 745.105 (j) (9) (a)-**
14 **(b), Ord. Code.** Two honorary roadside markers shall depict the
15 appropriate badge and/or emblem color for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya
16 as contemplated in Section 745.105 (j) (9) (a)-(b), *Ordinance Code*, to
17 read as follows:

18 **Fire and Rescue Officer**

19 **Lieutenant Mario J. Moya**

20 **End of Watch**

21 **August 17, 2021**

22 **Section 3. Honorary Roadside Markers for Lieutenant Mario**
23 **J. Moya to be installed.** Two honorary roadside markers, as
24 contemplated by Section 745.105, *Ordinance Code*, recognizing and
25 honoring Lieutenant Mario J. Moya shall be placed in appropriate
26 locations at the intersection of San Jose Blvd and Ricky Drive and
27 in front of Fire Station 42 located at 2948 Delor Drive, Jacksonville.

28 **Section 4. Waiver of Section 745.105(i)(2), Ord. Code.**
29 Section 745.105(i)(2), Ord. Code which requires that the honoree be
30 deceased for a least five years is hereby waived due to the fact that
31 the honoree died while in the Line of Duty.

1 **Section 5. Waiver of Section 745.105(j) (10), Ord. Code.**

2 Section 745.105(j) (10), Ord. Code which requires that the Planning
3 and Development Department send two written notifications to affected
4 property owners is hereby waived because no property owners are
5 addressed from or affected by the designated portion of Ricky Drive.

6 **Section 6. Directing Legislative Services to forward a copy**
7 **to the Planning and Development Department.** The Chief of Legislative
8 Services is requested to send a copy of this legislation, once
9 enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit,
10 for processing, implementation, and coordination with the Public
11 Works Department, Traffic Engineering Division and other affected
12 agencies and organizations.

13 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
14 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
15 without the Mayor's signature.
