Moya treated and transported yet another COVID-19 positive patient. In the days that followed, Lt. Moya was diagnosed with the very same virus that he helped so many others overcome.

On August 17, 2021, and after a valiant battle, Lt. Moya succumbed to the COVID-19 virus that he contracted while serving JFRD and this community. Because he contracted COVID-19 while performing his duties as a JFRD firefighter, his passing is considered a line-of-duty death. As such, Lt. Moya received all the honors and benefits associated with the ultimate sacrifice he made in service to others.
