AN ORDINANCE CLOSING AND ABANDONING AND/OR DISCLAIMING A 24 FOOT DRAINAGE AND UTILITIES RIGHT-OF-WAY ESTABLISHED IN THE WISPERING PINES PLAT, AS RECORDED IN PLAT BOOK 26, PAGE 15 OF THE CURRENT PUBLIC RECORDS OF DUVAL COUNTY, FLORIDA, IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 10, AT THE REQUEST OF ROBERT'S DIESEL SERVICE, INC.; PROVIDING FOR APPROVAL SUBJECT TO CONDITIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Section 1. Closure and Abandonment. (the "Applicant"). The Applicant paid the right-of-way closure application fee of \$2,091.00 and the closure and abandonment with encroachment fee of \$516.00, both of which have been deposited into the General Fund. This closure request was reviewed and approved by the various city, state, and utility agencies that might have an interest in the right-of-way and there
