5 AN ORDINANCE APPROVING THE PROPOSED 2021B SERIES
6 TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE CONSERVATION/COASTAL
7 MANAGEMENT ELEMENT OF THE *2030 COMPREHENSIVE*
8 *PLAN* OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, TO UPDATE
9 JAXPORT MASTER PLAN MAP 17, THE JAXPORT
10 PROPERTIES AND RELATED USES MAP, FOR TRANSMITTAL
11 TO THE STATE OF FLORIDA'S VARIOUS AGENCIES FOR
12 REVIEW; PROVIDING A DISCLAIMER THAT THE
13 AMENDMENT TRANSMITTED HEREIN SHALL NOT BE
14 CONSTRUED AS AN EXEMPTION FROM ANY OTHER
15 APPLICABLE LAWS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

17 **WHEREAS**, the Planning and Development Department has initiated
18 certain revisions and modifications to the text of the *2030*
19 *Comprehensive Plan* in accordance with the procedures and requirements
20 set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, *Ordinance Code*, to amend the
21 Conservation/Coastal Management Element of the *2030 Comprehensive*
22 *Plan* to update JaxPort Master Plan Map 17, the JaxPort Properties and
23 Related Uses Map, to add a 27.07± acre parcel owned by the
24 Jacksonville Port Authority, as more particularly set forth in **Exhibit**
25 **1**, dated August 23, 2021, **attached hereto** and incorporated herein by
26 reference; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Planning Commission, as the Local
28 Planning Agency, held a public hearing on this proposed Amendment to
29 the *2030 Comprehensive Plan*, with due public notice having been
30 provided, and reviewed and considered all comments received during
31 the public hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council;

2 **WHEREAS**, the Land Use and Zoning (LUZ) Committee held a public
3 hearing on this proposed Amendment pursuant to Chapter 650, Part 4,
4 *Ordinance Code*, and having considered all written and oral comments
5 received during the public hearing, has made its recommendation to
6 the Council; and

7 **WHEREAS**, the City Council held a public hearing on this proposed
8 Amendment with public notice having been provided, pursuant to Section
9 163.3184(3), *Florida Statutes*, and Chapter 650, Part 4, *Ordinance*
10 *Code*, and having considered all written and oral comments received
11 during the public hearing, the recommendations of the Planning and
12 Development Department, the Planning Commission and the LUZ
13 Committee, desires to transmit this proposed Amendment through the
14 State's expedited state review process to the Florida Department of
15 Economic Opportunity, as the State Land Planning Agency, the Northeast
16 Florida Regional Council, the Florida Department of Transportation,
17 the St. Johns River Water Management District, the Florida Department
18 of Environmental Protection, the Florida Fish and Wildlife
19 Conservation Commission, the Department of State's Bureau of Historic
20 Preservation, the Florida Department of Education, and the Department
21 of Agriculture and Consumer Affairs; now, therefore

22 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council for the City of Jacksonville:

23 **Section 1. Approval of Amendment for Transmittal Purposes.**

24 The Council hereby approves the proposed 2021B Series Text Amendment
25 to the Conservation/Coastal Management Element of the 2030
26 *Comprehensive Plan*, as set forth in **Exhibit 1**, dated August 23, 2021,
27 and **attached hereto**, for transmittal to Florida's various required
28 State Agencies for review.

29 **Section 2. Disclaimer.** The transmittal approved herein

30 shall **not** be construed as an exemption from any other applicable
31 local, state, or federal laws, regulations, requirements, permits or

1 approvals. All other applicable local, state or federal permits or
2 approvals shall be obtained before commencement of the development
3 or use, and transmittal is based upon acknowledgement, representation
4 and confirmation made by the applicant(s), owner(s), developer(s)
5 and/or any authorized agent(s) or designee(s) that the subject
6 business, development and/or use will be operated in strict compliance
7 with all laws. Transmittal does not approve, promote or condone any
8 practice or act that is prohibited or restricted by any federal,
9 state or local laws.

10 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
11 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
12 without the Mayor's signature.
