Bill Summary: This ordinance establishes an honorary street designation and associated roadway markers in Council District 6 for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya, a Fallen Fire and Rescue officer who died in the line of duty in August of 2021. It waives Ordinance Code Section 745.105(I)(2) which requires that the honoree be deceased for at least 5 years.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is for Ricky Drive to receive an honorary street designation for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya in Council District 6. This bill also provides for the installation of two honorary roadside markers to be located in appropriate locations on the designated roadway. The Chief of Legislative Services is requested to send a copy of the enacted legislation once enacted to the Planning and Development Department for processing, implementation, and coordination with 911 Emergency, Fire and Rescue Department, the Post Office, and other affected agencies.
