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## ORDINANCE 2022-34

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AN ASSUMPTION DOCUMENT REGARDING THE AMENDED AND RESTATED AGREEMENT FOR RESIDENTIAL WASTE AND RECYCLING AND TRANSPORTATION COLLECTION (CONTRACT NO. 9165) ("AMENDED AND RESTATED AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE ("CITY") AND WASTE MANAGEMENT INC. OF FLORIDA ("WASTE MANAGEMENT"), A FLORIDA CORPORATION (THE "ASSUMPTION DOCUMENT"); APPROVING THE TRANSFER BY CORPORATE MERGER OF THE AMENDED AND RESTATED AGREEMENT TO WASTE MANAGEMENT WITH CONTINGENCY; WAIVING CERTAIN TRANSFERABILITY REQUIREMENTS OF SECTION 382.308 (CONTRACT PROVISIONS; EXEMPTIONS FROM PURCHASING CODE; EXTENSION OF CONTRACTS), PART 3 (SELECTION OF WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE AREAS AND CONTRACTORS), CHAPTER 382 (WASTE COLLECTION AND DISPOSAL SERVICE BY CONTRACTORS AND CITY), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR THE ASSUMPTION DOCUMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND WASTE MANAGEMENT; PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE SOLID WASTE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Restated Agreement for Residential Waste and Recycling Collection and Transportation Services between the City of Jacksonville ("City") and Advanced Disposal Services Jacksonville, LLC ("ADS"), dated October 23, 2015 (the "Amended and Restated Agreement") contained **On File** and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the letter dated October 1, 2021, from

LLC ("Advanced Disposal") entered into that certain Amended and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the letter dated October 1, 2021, from Waste Management Inc. of Florida, a Florida corporation ("Waste Management") contained On File ADS was merged with Waste Management, effective December 31, 2021; and

WHEREAS, as of December 31, 2021, Waste Management, pursuant to the corporate merger, will provide the services to the City in accordance with the Amended and Restated Agreement;

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 382.308 of the Ordinance Code, the City desires to approve the transfer by corporate merger of the Amended and Restated Agreement to Waste Management, and Waste Management agrees to assume the obligations under the Amended and Restated Agreement; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Recitals. The recitals above are incorporated herein by reference.

Section 2. Execution of Assumption Document authorized. The Mayor or his designee and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver an assumption document in accordance with Section 382.308(b)(1), Ordinance Code ("Assumption Document"). The Assumption Document shall require Waste Management to comply with, assume and perform all liabilities, obligations, conditions, standards and services imposed by the Amended and Restated Agreement in accordance with Section 382.308(b)(1) of the Ordinance Code, and the Assumption Document shall be reviewed and approved by the Office of General Counsel as to form.

Section 3. the Amended and Restated Agreement with contingency. approves the transfer by corporate merger of the Amended and Restated Agreement 382.308(b)(1), Ordinance Code, subject to the waiver in Section 4 and contingent upon Waste Management's execution of the Assumption

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Document. The Council's approval of the transfer by corporate merger of the Amended and Restated Agreement to Waste Management pursuant to this section shall become effective as of the date that the Assumption Document is fully executed by the City and Waste Management. Section 4. Waiving certain transferability requirements of Section 382.308 (Contract provisions; exemption from Purchasing Code; extension of contracts), Part 3 (Selection of Waste Collection and Disposal Service Areas and Contractors), Chapter 382 Collection and Disposal Service by Contractors and City) Ordinance Code. The transferability requirements set forth in Section

contract transfers in the same manner and based on the same criteria as provided in Sections 382.306 and 382.307 of the Code, are waived to allow the City and Waste Management to execute the Assumption Document.

Section 5. Oversight Department. The Solid Waste Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the Assumption Document and matters described in this ordinance.

This ordinance shall become Section 6. Effective Date. effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.

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
