A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING KRISTI C. SIKES FOR HER DECADES OF SERVICE TO THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE CITIZENS OF JACKSONVILLE ON THE OCCASION OF HER RETIREMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Kristi Cook Sikes, a native of Jacksonville, graduated from Terry Parker High School and earned her bachelor's degree in management from the University of North Florida; and

WHEREAS, after college graduation Ms. Sikes held several positions at Barnett Bank, including Manager of Customer Service, before following in her father's footsteps and entering public service with the Jacksonville City Council. Ms. Sikes' father, Henry Cook, served two terms on the City Council from 1979 to 1987, was twice elected Council President by his colleagues (one of only a small handful of members elected to multiple terms as President), and thereafter served 14 years as the county Clerk of the Courts; and

WHEREAS, in June of 1992 Kristi Sikes was appointed Chief of Council Administration, the division responsible for all administrative support of the Council and its staff and operations, including payroll and leave processing, hiring and on-boarding new employees, insurance, procurement, property management and inventory control, budgeting and accounting, memberships and subscriptions, logistics, and other related functions; and

WHEREAS, for the past 30 years Ms. Sikes and her staff have been the unseen foundation of the Council's operations, quietly and efficiently keeping the paychecks coming and insurance policies in

force, paying the bills, ensuring that the offices are kept clean and comfortable and the office equipment in good repair, the phones and computers operating, the office supplies room fully stocked, the budget submitted timely and accurately, records organized and permanently stored, and otherwise managing the dozens of tasks, large and small, that are needed to keep a large and complicated office operating smoothly; and

WHEREAS, while such records are hard to research, it is believed that Kristi Sikes may hold the current record for the longest tenure of a City employee in the position into which they were originally hired, a few months shy of 30 years in the position of Chief of Administrative Services (the original job title having been changed by Ordinance Code amendment in 2000); and

WHEREAS, Ms. Sikes has recently announced her retirement and the Council wishes to express its appreciation for her long years of dedicated service; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Kristi Sikes for her three decades of outstanding service to the City of Jacksonville and thanks her for her dedication and diligence in service to the citizens of Jacksonville. The Council extends its very best wishes for many years of health and happiness in her retirement.

Section 2. **Effective Date.** This Resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
