AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$15,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION (THE "FWC") FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S COSTS TO REMOVE ONE DERELICT VESSEL LOCATED IN A PUBLIC WATERWAY IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, INITIATED BY B.T. 22-022; PURPOSE APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$15,000.00 in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (the "FWC") for reimbursement to the City of the costs to remove one derelict vessel located

in a public waterway within the City.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to appropriate grant funding from the FWC to offset the City's costs for removal of one derelict vessel located in a public waterway within the City. Pursuant to that certain State of Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No. 21086 (the "Agreement"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to \$15,000.00 for removal of one 40 foot Shellcraft Commercial Trawler located at 9998 Old Lem Turner Road in the Trout River. Removal of this vessel must occur prior to expiration of Agreement on January 15, 2022. A copy of the Agreement is On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 3. Oversight. The Environmental Quality Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall provide oversight of the project described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
