## ORDINANCE 2021-849-E

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$500,000.00 (\$250,000 FROM COUNCIL PRESIDENT CONTINGENCY EXPENSE ACCOUNT AND \$250,000 FROM CONTINGENCY FIND MATCH) FOR FUNDING TO EDWARD WATERS UNIVERSITY TO PROVIDE A COMMUNITY WELLNESS AND FITNESS CENTER; PROVIDING FOR CARRYOVER OF FUNDS FISCAL YEAR 2022-2023; APPROVING AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER AGREEMENTS WITH EDWARD WATERS UNIVERSITY, INC.; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF SECTION 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO DIRECT CONTRACT EDWARD WATERS UNIVERSITY, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF SERVICES RELATED TO THE COMMUNITY WELLNESS AND FITNESS CENTER, AS MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED HEREIN; WAIVING SECTION 118.107 (NONPROFITS TO RECEIVE FUNDING THROUGH A COMPETITIVE EVALUATED AWARD PROCESS), PART 1 (GENERAL PROVISIONS), CHAPTER 118 (CITY GRANTS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW DIRECT CONTRACT WITH EDWARD WATERS UNIVERSITY; WAIVING SECTION 118.201(F)(7) (RELEASE OF APPROPRIATIONS), ORDINANCE CODE, TO ALLOW FOR

ADVANCE PAYMENTS IN EXCESS OF 10% TO EDWARD WATERS UNIVERSITY; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Edward Waters University (EWU) intends and commits for the EWU Community Wellness and Fitness Center to be available for community/public use through its existing Schell-Sweet Community Resource Center and Center for Health Disparities which has a longstanding years-long history of continued public service to Jacksonville citizens and particularly seniors and families who reside in the New Town and NW Jacksonville community; and

WHEREAS, the Center will also be dually used by EWU students, faculty, and staff. Collectively, New Town and NW Jacksonville citizens as well as members of the EWU community lack proximate access to adequate health and wellness facilities; and

WHEREAS, as a public service to quell the proliferation of persistent health disparities plaguing this low-income, aging, and largely minority community (i.e., New Town and NW Jacksonville community) as well as to primarily serve its largely minority and low income student community (where nearly 86% of students are pell-eligible—low income), EWU seeks to provide access to a geographically accessible, safe, and modernly equipped wellness and fitness facility to Jacksonville citizens and its students to further advance and augment the aforementioned existing health/wellness education opportunities being offered by the university; and

WHEREAS, for the foregoing reasons, the City Council determines that the Community Wellness and Fitness Center serves a public purpose; now therefore

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Appropriation. For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,

within the City's budget, there is hereby appropriated the indicated sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s) listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding is provided by \$250,000 from the Council President Contingency account appropriated in Ordinance 2021-504-E and \$250,000 from unused Contingency for matches for the FIND Grants.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to provide funding to Edward Waters University to support a Community Wellness and Fitness Center, and equip the center with fitness equipment, as more fully described in Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev Scope, January 3, 2022 - NCSPHS", attached hereto.

Section 3. Carryover. The funds appropriated in this Ordinance shall not lapse but shall carryover to fiscal year 2022-2023.

The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver a Grant Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 3, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 3, Rev Joint Use Agreement, January 11, 2022 - Floor" and a Joint Use Agreement in substantially the form attached hereto as

Revised Exhibit 4, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 4, Rev Grant Agreement, January 11, 2022 - Floor" between the City of Jacksonville and Edward Waters University, Inc. to provide for a Community Health and Fitness Center at EWU. The agreements may include such extensions, renewals, additions, deletions and changes as may be reasonable, necessary and incidental for carrying out the purposes thereof, as may be acceptable to the Mayor, or his designee, with such inclusion and acceptance being evidenced by execution of the agreement by the Mayor, or his designee; provided however, no modifications to the agreement may increase the financial obligations or liability of the City to an amount in excess of the amount stated in the agreement or decrease the duties and obligations of EWU, and any such modifications shall be technical only and shall be subject to appropriate legal review and approval by the Office of General Counsel and the Office of Risk Management for appropriate insurance and indemnification terms. For the purposes of this Ordinance, the term "technical changes" is defined as those changes having no financial impact to the City and any other non-substantive changes that do not substantively increase the duties and responsibilities of the City under the provisions of the agreement.

Section 5. Invoking the exception to Section 126.107(g), The City is hereby authorized to enter direct Ordinance Code. agreements or amendments to agreements, as authorized herein, with Edward Waters University, Inc., for the purposes of providing services for the Program. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically described in the authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full

force and effect. The failure of any entity identified herein to enter into the applicable agreement or amendment to the agreement with the City shall render such entity ineligible to receive the Grant funds authorized hereby.

The provisions of Section 118.107 (Nonprofits to receive funding through a competitive evaluated award process), Part 1 (General Provisions), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, are hereby waived to allow for a direct contract with EWU and the City of Jacksonville. The Council finds that waiver of Section 118.107, Ordinance Code, is necessary and justified to allow a direct contract with EWU. EWU is a Historic Black College and University (HBCU) located in an area with significant public health challenges. EWU is uniquely situated to provide a benefit to the public health and welfare by providing public access to the community through its Community Wellness and Fitness Center. EWU has agreed to provide free community access to the Community Wellness and Fitness Center for the first five (5) The Council finds that only EWU could provide this service to the community and therefore a direct contract with EWU is warranted.

Section 7. Waiver of Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release Appropriations), Ordinance Code. Section 118.201(f)(7) (Release of Appropriations), Chapter 118 (City Grants), Ordinance Code, is hereby waived as to the disbursement of funds based upon draws for services performed or reimbursements for work done. Waiver of Section 118.201(f)(7), Ordinance Code, is requested to allow advance payments in excess of 10% to EWU.
