Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the Locally-Funded Agreement (Lump-Sum) between the State of Florida Department of Transportation and the City of Jacksonville for a road repaving project. The Engineering and Construction Management Division of the Department of Public Works will provide oversight for the project.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to help fund certain roadway improvements on Main Street (SR 5/US 17), to include milling and resurfacing on Main Street from State Street to the Trout River and the installation of traffic calming improvements from 1st Street to 12th Street. The City's contribution will be funded from a proposed project in the FY 2022-2023 Capital Improvement Plan and is contingent upon City Council approval.
