Type of Action: Authorization execution of an assumption of an amended and restated solid waste and recycling collection contract; approval of contract transfer by corporate merger; Ordinance Code waiver; designation of oversight agency

Bill Summary: The bill authorizes execution of an assumption document by which Waste Management, Inc. assumes the solid waste collection and recycling contract currently held by Advanced Disposal Services Jacksonville, LLC ("ADS") to provide service to the City of Jacksonville. The City Council approves the transfer of the waste hauling contract from ADS to Waste Management via a corporate merger, and waives the Ordinance Code requirement that both companies involved in a sale, assignment or transfer of a City contract must submit applications to the City for transfer approval in the same form as applications for new service provision. The Solid Waste Division of the Public Works Department is designated as the City's oversight agency for the contract.

Background Information: In late 2020, Waste Management Inc. completed the acquisition of Advanced Disposal Services, a sale that was originally announced in early 2019. Now that the process of merging the ADS corporate assets into Waste Management is complete, the company is ready to formally assume control of ADS's contract to provide waste hauling and recycling services on Jacksonville's Westside. City Council is required by the Ordinance Code to approve transfers of waste hauler contracts.

Policy Impact Area: Solid waste services

Fiscal Impact: None; Waste Management is assuming ADS's existing contract which runs through the end of the current fiscal year.
