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## ORDINANCE 2022-48

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2021B SERIES TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN 2030 OF THE CTTY OF JACKSONVILLE, CREATING A NEW FUTURE LAND USE POLICY 3.1.27 ELEMENT (FLUE) TO ALLOW FOR CONSIDERATION TO AMEND LAND USE AND ZONING OF LEGAL LOTS OF RECORD EXISTING BEFORE SEPTEMBER 21, 1990, TO PERMIT DEVELOPMENT OF ONE SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING PER LOT, SUBJECT TO CASE-BY-CASE REVIEW FOR CONSISTENCY WITH THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Council Member Diamond, as Chair of the Land Use and 17 Zoning Committee, has initiated certain revisions and modifications 18 19 to the text of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the 20 procedures and requirements set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, 21 Ordinance Code, facilitate the appropriate to and timely 22 implementation of the plan, and has provided the necessary supporting 23 data and analysis to support and justify the amendments determined 24 to be required, and accordingly, has proposed certain revisions and 25 modifications, which are more particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, 26 dated January 4, 2022, attached hereto and incorporated herein by 27 reference; and

WHEREAS, the City, by the adoption of Ordinance 2021-543-E, approved this amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan for transmittal to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), as the State Land Planning Agency, and other required state agencies, for review 1 and comment; and

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WHEREAS, by various letters and e-mails, the DEO and other state reviewing agencies transmitted their comments, if any, regarding this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

5 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department reviewed the 6 proposed revisions, considered all comments received, prepared a 7 written report and rendered an advisory recommendation to the Council 8 with respect to this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive 9 Plan; and

10 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, 11 held a public hearing on this proposed amendment to the 2030 12 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and 13 reviewed and considered all comments received during the public 14 hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 650.408 Ordinance Code, the Land Use and Zoning Committee held a public hearing in accordance with the requirements of Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, on this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, and has made its recommendation to the City Council; and

20 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), *Florida Statutes*, and 21 Chapter 650, Part 4, *Ordinance Code*, the City Council held a public 22 hearing, with public notice having been provided, on this proposed 23 amendment to the *2030 Comprehensive Plan*; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further considered all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, including the data collection and analysis portions of this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the recommendations of the Planning and Development Department and the Planning Commission, the final recommendations of the Land Use and Zoning Committee, and the comments, if any, of the DEO and the other state agencies; and

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WHEREAS, in the exercise of its authority, the City Council has

determined it necessary and desirable to adopt this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan to preserve and enhance present advantages, encourage the most appropriate use of land, water and resources, consistent with public interest, overcome present deficiencies, and deal effectively with future problems that may result from the use and development of land within the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore

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**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. 9 Purpose and Intent. This Ordinance is adopted 10 to carry out the purpose and intent of, and exercise the authority set out in, the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land 11 Development Regulation Act, Sections 163.3161 through 163.3248, 12 13 Florida Statutes, and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as amended. The 14 amendment modifies the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan of the City of Jacksonville, to create a new FLUE 15 16 Policy 3.1.27 to allow for consideration to amend the land use and 17 zoning of legal lots of record existing before September 21, 1990, 18 to permit development of one single-family dwelling per lot regardless 19 of the availability of centralized water or sewer facility connections 20 and related density or lot area requirements, subject to case-by-case 21 review for consistency with the Comprehensive Plan.

22 Section 2. Amendment to Comprehensive Plan. The 2030 23 Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include the revisions to the 24 text of the Future Land Use Element from the 2021B Series, which has 25 been initiated by Council Member Diamond as Chair of the Land Use and 26 Zoning Committee, as more particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, dated 27 January 4, 2022, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference.

28 Section 3. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 29 effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 30 without the Mayor's signature.
