1 Introduced by Council Members Bowman, Priestly Jackson, Salem, 2 Morgan, Pittman, Carrico, White, Diamond, Becton and Ferraro: 3 4 5 ORDINANCE 2022-56 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 123 (PUBLIC FEES); 6 7 CREATING A NEW SECTION 123.108 (MILITARY AND 8 VETERANS' APPRECIATION PROGRAM; REDUCTION OF 9 CERTAIN PARK FEES FOR MILITARY AND VETERANS), (IN GENERAL), CHAPTER 123 (PUBLIC 10 PART ONE FEES), ORDINANCE CODE, TO CODIFY A PERMANENT 11 PROGRAM FOR REDUCED ADMISSION AT CERTAIN PARKS; 12 13 PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE PARKS, RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; 14 DIRECTIVE TO LEGISLATIVE SERVICES; DIRECTIVE TO 15 CITY WEBMASTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE. 16 17 WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville ("City") recognizes the strong 18 presence of active military service members and veterans living in 19 20 Jacksonville and the surrounding communities; and 21 WHEREAS, through Ordinance 2021-212-E, the City created a pilot 22 program to reduce the park admission fees for active service members 23 and veterans by ½ for admission to Kathryn Abbey Hanna Park and 24 Huguenot Memorial Park; and 25 WHEREAS, finding that the pilot program was successful, the 26 Council now finds that the fee reduction program should be made permanent through creation of a new section in the Ordinance Code, 27 Section 123.108; now therefore 28 29 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

30 Section 1. Creating a new Section 123.108 (Military and 31 Veterans' Appreciation Program; Reduction of certain park fees for 1 military and veterans), Part 1 (In General), Chapter 123 (Public 2 Fees), Ordinance Code. Section 123.108 (Military and Veterans' 3 Appreciation Program; Reduction of certain park fees for military and 4 veterans), Part 1 (In General), Chapter 123 (Public Fees), Ordinance 5 Code, is hereby created to add a new section as follows:

CHAPTER 123. PUBLIC FEES.

PART 1. IN GENERAL.

## 9 Sec. 123.108. Military and Veterans' Appreciation Program; 10 Reduction of certain park fees for military and veterans.

11 There is herby approved and adopted within the City a "Military and Veterans' Appreciation Program." The Parks, Recreation and Community 12 Services Department is authorized to reduce current daily admission 13 fees by 1/2 for fees charged at Kathryn Abbey Hanna Park and Huguenot 14 15 Memorial Park (which may be applied to car, pedestrian and biker admission but not on annual passes) for all active military service 16 17 members, veterans, and their immediate family members (spouse and children with valid military identification), regardless of residency 18 in Jacksonville. In order to qualify for the reduced admission fees, 19 20 the active military service member or veteran (or their immediate 21 family member), must produce at the park entrance at the time of 22 admission a state issued military ID, DD214 ID, or veteran ID.
