6 **ORDINANCE 2021-882-E**

7 AN ORDINANCE REGARDING CHAPTER 745 (ADDRESSING
8 AND STREET NAMING REGULATIONS) *ORDINANCE CODE*;
9 ESTABLISHING AN HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION AND
10 ASSOCIATED ROADWAY MARKERS FOR LIEUTENANT MARIO
11 J. MOYA, A FALLEN FIRE AND RESCUE OFFICER WHO
12 DIED WHILE IN THE LINE OF DUTY; ESTABLISHING AN
13 HONORARY STREET DESIGNATION ON RICKY DRIVE IN
14 COUNCIL DISTRICT 6 FOR LIEUTENANT MARIO J. MOYA;
15 PROVIDING FOR THE ROADSIDE MARKERS FOR
16 LIEUTENANT MARIO J. MOYA BE DEPICTED AS
17 CONTEMPLATED IN SECTION 745.105
18 (J) (9) (B); PROVIDING FOR THE INSTALLATION OF TWO
19 HONORARY ROADWAY MARKERS TO BE LOCATED IN
20 APPROPRIATE LOCATIONS ON THE DESIGNATED ROADWAY
21 IN COUNCIL DISTRICT 6; WAIVER OF SECTION 745.105
22 (I) (2) WHICH REQUIRES THAT THE HONOREE BE
23 DECEASED FOR AT LEAST 5 YEARS; WAIVER OF SECTION
24 745.105 (J) (10), ORD. CODE WHICH REQUIRES THAT
25 THE PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT SEND TWO
26 WRITTEN NOTIFICATIONS TO AFFECTED PROPERTY
27 OWNERS; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE SERVICES
28 DIVISION TO FORWARD THIS ORDINANCE TO THE
29 PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT DEPARTMENT FOR
30 PROCESSING, IMPLEMENTATION, AND COORDINATION

1 WITH THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT, TRAFFIC
2 ENGINEERING DIVISION AND OTHER AFFECTED AGENCIES
3 AND ORGANIZATIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

5 **WHEREAS**, the Jacksonville Fire and Rescue Department (JFRD)
6 submitted a request for an Honorary Street Name Designation to honor
7 Fire and Rescue Lieutenant Mario J. Moya; (Correspondence from the
8 Office of the Director/Fire Chief, City of Jacksonville Fire and
9 Rescue Department is attached hereto as **Exhibit 1**); and

10 **WHEREAS**, Section 745.105 (j)(9)(b), Ord. Code, provides for
11 honorary designations for fallen fire and rescue officers who die
12 while in the Line of Duty; and

13 **WHEREAS**, in accordance with the criteria established pursuant
14 to Florida law, Lieutenant Mario J. Moya died while in the Line of
15 Duty; (The Florida Joint Council of Fire and Emergency Services
16 Firefighter Line-of-Duty Death Memorial Selection Process is attached
17 hereto as **Exhibit 2**); and

18 **WHEREAS**, Lt. Moya dedicated 17 years to the JFRD assigned as a
19 Firefighter to Rescue 42 on the B-shift, and was promoted up the
20 ranks to a Lieutenant position; and

21 **WHEREAS**, the Florida Joint Council of Fire and Emergency
22 Services will honor Lt. Moya's name on the Memorial Wall at the
23 Florida Fallen Firefighter Memorial in Ocala, Florida, and at the
24 State Capitol; (See attached **Exhibit 2**); and

25 **WHEREAS**, there will be additional events to recognize the memory
26 of Lt. Moya which include a "Ringing of the Bell" ceremony, a "Last
27 Guard" ritual, presentation of a fallen firefighter memorial flag and
28 a medallion; and

29 **WHEREAS**, the Council finds that the accomplishments of
30 Lieutenant Mario J. Moya are worthy and deserving of a form of
31 recognition that the City of Jacksonville and Lieutenant Mario J.

1 Moya's family, friends and colleagues can share and celebrate in, to
2 wit: the creation of an honorary street designation and the
3 installation of two appropriate honorary roadway markers on Ricky
4 Drive in Council District 6; now therefore,

5 **WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section 745.105(i)(3), Ord. Code, the
6 honoree lived in excess of 10 years in the community located within
7 5 miles of the location for the honorary designation; and

8 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

9 **Section 1. Ricky Drive to receive an honorary street**
10 **designation for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya.** Ricky Drive in Council
11 District 6 shall hereby be designated as contemplated by Section
12 745.105, *Ordinance Code*, for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya. A map of the
13 road designation is attached hereto as **Exhibit 3**.

14 **Section 2. Honorary Roadside Markers for Lieutenant Mario**
15 **J. Moya to be depicted as authorized in Section 745.105 (j) (9) (a)-**
16 **(b), Ord. Code.** Two honorary roadside markers shall depict the
17 appropriate badge and/or emblem color for Lieutenant Mario J. Moya
18 as contemplated in Section 745.105 (j) (9) (a)-(b), *Ordinance Code*, to
19 read as follows:

20 **Fire and Rescue Officer**

21 **Lieutenant Mario J. Moya**

22 **End of Watch**

23 **August 17, 2021**

24 **Section 3. Honorary Roadside Markers for Lieutenant Mario**
25 **J. Moya to be installed.** Two honorary roadside markers, as
26 contemplated by Section 745.105, *Ordinance Code*, recognizing and
27 honoring Lieutenant Mario J. Moya shall be placed in appropriate
28 locations at the intersection of San Jose Blvd and Ricky Drive and
29 in front of Fire Station 42 located at 2948 Delor Drive, Jacksonville.

30 **Section 4. Waiver of Section 745.105(i)(2), Ord. Code.**
31 Section 745.105(i)(2), Ord. Code which requires that the honoree be

1 deceased for a least five years is hereby waived due to the fact that
2 the honoree died while in the Line of Duty.

3 **Section 5. Waiver of Section 745.105(j)(10), Ord. Code.**
4 Section 745.105(j)(10), Ord. Code which requires that the Planning
5 and Development Department send two written notifications to affected
6 property owners is hereby waived because no property owners are
7 addressed from or affected by the designated portion of Ricky Drive.

8 **Section 6. Directing Legislative Services to forward a copy**
9 **to the Planning and Development Department.** The Chief of Legislative
10 Services is requested to send a copy of this legislation, once
11 enacted, to the Planning and Development Department, Addressing Unit,
12 for processing, implementation, and coordination with the Public
13 Works Department, Traffic Engineering Division and other affected
14 agencies and organizations.

15 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This ordinance shall become
16 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
17 without the Mayor's signature.
