The funding above represents an appropriation of \$18,833.39 from the Art in Public Places Project fund to the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places Project (the "Project") to cover increased costs for completion of the Project.

5 Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in 6 Section 1 is to appropriate funds to the Winton Drive Park Art in 7 Public Places Project. This appropriation is necessary to cover 8 increased construction costs for completion of the Project which will 9 be installed in the Winton Drive Triangle at the corner of Winton 10 Drive and Howell Drive.

Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 11 Section 3. 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan 12 13 (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to appropriate funds from the Art in Public Places 14 15 Project fund to the Winton Drive Park Art in Public Places Project for completion of the Project as more fully described in the Project 16 17 Information Sheets attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, Rev CIP, January 18, 2022 - NCSPHS" and 18 incorporated herein by this reference. The City Council finds that 19 20 the deferral of this amendment of the CIP until the next annual budget 21 and CIP review will be detrimental to the best interests of the 22 community because such deferral will unnecessarily delay completion 23 of the Project.

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.
