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## ORDINANCE 2022-33-E

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AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, THAT CERTAIN SOVEREIGNTY SUBMERGED LANDS MODIFICATION (BOT FILE NO. 161181122) BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE INTERNAL IMPROVEMENT TRUST FUND OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA (THE "LEASE") TO REFLECT A CHANGE IN UPLAND OWNERSHIP, TO ADD THE CITY AS A NEW PARTY TO THE LEASE IN PLACE OF THE PREVIOUS LESSEE, AND TO ALLOW FOR REMOVAL OF AN EXISTING DOCK STRUCTURE; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT OF THE LEASE AND DOCKING FACILITY ΒY THE RECREATION AND COMMUNITY SERVICES DEPARTMENT; REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

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Approved. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, that certain Sovereignty Submerged Lands Lease Modification (BOT File No. 161181122) between the City of Jacksonville and the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida, in substantially the same form as has been placed On File with the Office of Legislative Services (the "Lease"). This Lease will allow the City to operate the River City Marina, a 58-slip commercial docking

facility exclusively for the mooring of recreational vessels in conjunction with an upland restaurant. The location of the docking facility is shown in **Exhibit 1**, attached hereto. The purpose of the Lease modification is to reflect a change in upland ownership, to add the City as a new party to the Lease in place of the previous lessee, Maritime Concepts, L.C., and to allow for removal of the existing dock structure prior to the Lease expiration date of February 17, 2022.

Section 2. Oversight. The Parks, Recreation and Community Services Department shall provide oversight of the Lease and the docking facility.

Section 3. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency. One cycle emergency passage of this legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is to ensure the Lease is executed prior to February 2022 as required by the Florida Department of Environmental Protection.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
