## RESOLUTION 2022-44-A

A RESOLUTION HONORING AND COMMENDING KRISTI C. SIKES FOR HER DECADES OF SERVICE TO THE CITY COUNCIL AND THE CITIZENS OF JACKSONVILLE ON THE OCCASION OF HER RETIREMENT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Kristi Cook Sikes, a native of Jacksonville, graduated from Terry Parker High School and earned her bachelor's degree in management from the University of North Florida; and

WHEREAS, after college graduation Ms. Sikes held several 16 positions at Barnett Bank, including Manager of Customer Service, 17 before following in her father's footsteps and entering public service 18 with the Jacksonville City Council. Ms. Sikes' father, Henry Cook, 19 20 served two terms on the City Council from 1979 to 1987, was twice 21 elected Council President by his colleagues (one of only a small 22 handful of members elected to multiple terms as President), and 23 thereafter served 14 years as the county Clerk of the Courts; and

24 WHEREAS, in June of 1992 Kristi Sikes was appointed Chief of 25 responsible Council Administration, the division for all 26 administrative support of the Council and its staff and operations, 27 including payroll and leave processing, hiring and on-boarding new 28 employees, insurance, procurement, property management and inventory control, budgeting and accounting, memberships and subscriptions, 29 logistics, and other related functions; and 30

WHEREAS, for the past 30 years Ms. Sikes and her staff have been

the unseen foundation of the Council's operations, quietly and 1 2 efficiently keeping the paychecks coming and insurance policies in force, paying the bills, ensuring that the offices are kept clean and 3 comfortable and the office equipment in good repair, the phones and 4 computers operating, the office supplies room fully stocked, the 5 budget submitted timely and accurately, records organized and 6 7 permanently stored, and otherwise managing the dozens of tasks, large and small, that are needed to keep a large and complicated office 8 9 operating smoothly; and

10 WHEREAS, while such records are hard to research, it is believed 11 that Kristi Sikes may hold the current record for the longest tenure 12 of a City employee in the position into which they were originally 13 hired, a few months shy of 30 years in the position of Chief of 14 Administrative Services (the original job title having been changed 15 by Ordinance Code amendment in 2000); and

16 WHEREAS, Ms. Sikes has recently announced her retirement and 17 the Council wishes to express its appreciation for her long years of 18 dedicated service; now therefore
