Bill Summary: This bill authorizes a 36-year license agreement extension between the City of Jacksonville and the Jacksonville Skeet and Trap Club, Inc. for property located at 12125 New Berlin Road.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to extend the term of the license agreement (currently scheduled to expire December 31, 2025) to December 31, 2061, with two, five-year extension options; clarify mortgagee rights under the Agreement; provide a right of first refusal for the Company to purchase the property; clarify the description of the licensed premises; and make other additional technical changes. The revised agreement changes the annual license fee from \$2,500 per year plus a \$6,000 per year land acquisition fee to \$1 per year.

Established in 1936, Jacksonville Clay Target Sports is one of the oldest, continuously operating gun clubs in the country, and it is open to the public and provides several different levels of memberships.

Policy Impact Area: Jacksonville Skeet and Trap Club

Fiscal Impact: Reduces the club's annual payment to \$1 per year.
