**Bill Summary:** The bill appropriates \$421,685 from the Judgements Recovered Fund to the Contractual Services Fund for restitution for damage to trees at the Pinehurst Cemetery. The Department of Public Works, Mowing and Landscape Division, shall provide oversight of the project.

**Background Information:** The appropriation of \$421,685 from Judgements Received Fund to the Contractual Services Fund is to pay for the removal of trees that were damaged due to a City contractor incorrectly spraying chemicals to treat weeds in Pinehurst Cemetery. Through an insurance claim, the contractor's insurance provider will cover the estimated costs of removal of damaged trees and ensure that the removed trees do not create a safety hazard to the Pinehurst Cemetery property or persons visiting the cemetery.
