Type of Action: Ordinance Code amendment

Bill Summary: The bill removes Sec. 110.414 - Derelict Vessel and Floating Structure Removal Fund – from Ordinance Code Chapter 110 – City Treasury and replaces it with a new, slightly revised Sec. 111.787 – Derelict and Abandoned Vessels and Floating Structure Enforcement and Removal Trust Fund – in Ordinance Code Chapter 111 – Special Revenue and Trust Accounts.

Background Information: The revised section removes automatic appropriation language for use of the fund for designated purposes and requires appropriation by City Council. The revised section also assigns responsibility for administration, regulation and enforcement of Ordinance Code Chapter 388 - Boating and Waterways – to the Neighborhoods Department

Policy Impact Area: Derelict vessel and floating structure removal. Chapter 388 enforcement

Fiscal Impact: The bill will require Council appropriation of derelict vessel funds for use
