Capital Improvement Plan Amendment. Ordinance 8 Section 3. 9 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is 10 hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the 11 Project as more fully described in the Project Information Sheets 12 attached hereto as Revised Exhibit 2, labeled as "Revised Exhibit 2, 13 Rev CIP, January 31, 2022 - NCSPHS" and incorporated herein by this 14 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment 15 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be 16 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such 17 deferral will unnecessarily delay the opportunity to bring public art 18 to this part of the community. 19

Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), Ordinance Code, enactment of this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

27 Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become 28 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 29 without the Mayor's signature.
