AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$30,000.00 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE CONSERVATION COMMISSION (THE "FWC") FOR REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S COSTS TO REMOVE TWO DERELICT VESSELS LOCATED IN PUBLIC WATERWAYS IN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-031; PURPOSE APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT, ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$30,000.00 in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (the "FWC") for reimbursement to the City of the costs to remove two derelict vessels

located in public waterways within the City.

Section 2. The purpose of the appropriation in Purpose. Section 1 is to appropriate grant funding from the FWC to offset the City's costs for removal of two derelict vessels located in public waterways within the City. Pursuant to that certain State of Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No. 21191 (the "Agreement"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to \$30,000.00 for removal of one 27 foot vessel of unknown make/model located on the south side of the channel on the northeast side of the SR17 bridge and one 26 foot sailboat of unknown make/model located off the intercoastal waterway near an abandoned property on the 600 block of Atlantic Boulevard. Removal of these vessels must occur prior to expiration of Agreement on April 29, 2022. Once removed, both vessels will be disposed of in an authorized landfill facility. A copy of the Agreement is On File with the Office of Legislative Services.

Section 3. Oversight. The Environmental Quality Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall provide oversight of the project described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
