**Bill Summary:** This bill is an appropriation of \$1,300,000 from the Nuisance Abatement Lien Special Revenue Fund pursuant to Section 111.470, *Ordinance Code*, to be used for nuisance abatement contractual services.

**Background Information:** The purpose of this legislation is to provide funding assistance to remove property code violations city-wide. \$637,000 is allocated to the Neighborhoods Department, Municipal Code Compliance Division, and the remaining \$663,000 is allocated to the Public Works Department, Mowing and Landscape Maintenance Division to be split between Mowing and Landscape – Private Property (\$400,000) and Mowing and Landscape - Tree Removal (\$263,000), for the procurement of these contractual services.
