(3) Distance limitation waiver pursuant to Part 8 (Alcoholic Beverages) of the Zoning Code,

regarding a package liquor store, as defined in Part 16 of the Zoning Code, so that the District Council Member may be notified in time to schedule a community meeting regarding the request if necessary.

As part of the application process for a package liquor store, the Department shall notify within five (5) business days of the application having been deemed complete, the District Council Member within whose District the subject property lies. Department shall make direct contact with the District Council Member regarding the application. For purposes of this Section, "direct contact" means a phone call or a meeting between the District Council Member and the Chief of Current Planning.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
