(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of \$421,685 paid to the City of Jacksonville by Berkley Program Specialists for damage caused to numerous trees located in Pinehurst Cemetery.

Section 2. Purpose. The purpose of the appropriation in

Section 1 is to pay for removal of trees in Pinehurst Cemetery that were significantly damaged or died after a City contractor sprayed incorrect chemicals on the cemetery property to treat for weeds. These funds were paid through an insurance claim filed with the contractor's insurance provider, Berkley Program Specialists, and will cover the City's estimated costs to remove all affected trees. Removal of the damaged and dead trees is necessary to ensure they do not become a safety hazard to the Pinehurst Cemetery property or persons visiting the cemetery.

Section 3. Oversight Department. The Department of Public Works, Mowing and Landscape Division, shall provide oversight of the project described herein.

Section 4. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
