## ORDINANCE 2022-55-E

APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, FOR AND ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, AN AMENDED AND RESTATED LICENSE **AGREEMENT** ("AGREEMENT") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE JACKSONVILLE SKEET AND TRAP CLUB, INC. ("COMPANY"), TO: EXTEND THE TERM OF AGREEMENT TO DECEMBER 31, 2061, WITH TWO, FIVE-YEAR EXTENSION OPTIONS; PROVIDE A RIGHT OF FIRST REFUSAL TO PURCHASE THE LICENSED PREMISES; CLARIFY MORTGAGEE RIGHTS UNDER THE AGREEMENT; CLARIFY THE BOUNDARIES OF THE LICENSED PREMISES; AND MAKE ADDITIONAL TECHNICAL REVISIONS AS SET FORTH IN THE AGREEMENT; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY THE REAL ESTATE DIVISION OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Amended and Restated License Agreement approved.

There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City, that certain Amended and Restated License Agreement in substantially the form placed Revised On File

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with the Legislative Services Division (the "Agreement"). The Agreement extends the term of the Agreement to December 31, 2061, with two, five-year extension options, clarifies mortgagee rights under the Agreement, provides a right of first refusal for the Company to purchase the property, clarifies the description of the licensed premises, and has additional technical changes as set forth therein.

Section 2. Oversight Department. The Real Estate Division of the Department of Public Works shall oversee the agreement described herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
