5 **RESOLUTION 2022-64-A**

6 A RESOLUTION REAPPOINTING JOSEPH "JOE" P.  
7 DISALVO, A DUVAL COUNTY RESIDENT, TO JEA,  
8 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 21, *JACKSONVILLE CHARTER*,  
9 FOR A FIRST FULL TERM EXPIRING FEBRUARY 28,  
10 2026; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

12 **WHEREAS**, prior to 2020, Article 21 of the Jacksonville Charter  
13 authorized the Mayor to appoint the JEA Board Members and the City  
14 Council to confirm the appointments; and

15 **WHEREAS**, in 2020, the entire JEA Board resigned, and the Mayor  
16 appointed seven new Members to the JEA; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Council confirmed the Mayor's appointment in  
18 Resolution 2020-156-A of Mr. Joseph DiSalvo to serve a partial term  
19 to February 28, 2022; and

20 **WHEREAS**, the City Council amended, and the voters ratified,  
21 changes to Article 21 of the Jacksonville Charter authorizing the  
22 Council to appoint 4 Members and the Mayor to appoint 3 Members to  
23 the JEA Board; and

24 **WHEREAS**, the partial term of Mr. DiSalvo has concluded; and

25 **WHEREAS**, the Mayor desires to reappoint Mr. DiSalvo as a member  
26 of the governing body of JEA, and have that member seat be designated  
27 as the Mayoral appointment; now therefore

28 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

29 **Section 1. Confirmation.** The Council hereby confirms the  
30 Mayor's reappointment of Joseph "Joe" P. DiSalvo, a Duval County  
31 resident, as a member of the governing body of JEA, pursuant to

1 Article 21, *Jacksonville Charter*, for a first full term expiring  
2 February 28, 2026.

3       **Section 2.       Effective Date.** This resolution shall become  
4 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
5 without the Mayor's signature.
