Background Information: The North Florida Transportation Planning Organization (TPO) is the independent regional transportation planning agency for Duval, Clay, Nassau and St. Johns counties and was established pursuant to Section 339.175, Florida Statutes, to lead the region's efforts in planning, funding and mobilizing resources to develop and maintain our transportation system.
