6 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE DUNCAN U. FLETCHER
7 HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS' VARSITY SOCCER TEAM FOR THEIR
8 OUTSTANDING SEASON AND UPON THEIR VICTORY IN THE
9 FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION CLASS
10 6A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
11 DATE.

13 **WHEREAS**, the Fletcher Senators Girls' Varsity Soccer Team has
14 not played in a state soccer semifinal since 2002, and their 1998
15 appearance was their only previous trip to the final; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the Lady Senators overcame multiple challenges on their
17 path to this year's state championship, including road victories at
18 Gainesville Buchholz High School, Navarre High School and Fleming
19 Island High School, and a state semifinal win against Viera High
20 School that required a rare direct corner kick goal to finally bring
21 home the trophy; and

22 **WHEREAS**, the team fought their way through the last month to go
23 on to encounter perhaps the biggest obstacle of the postseason, their
24 Miami opponents, Our Lady of Lourdes Academy. Lourdes previously won
25 the state championships in 2018 and 2020, and reached the state finals
26 in 2013, 2016 and 2021; and

27 **WHEREAS**, the Senators Girls' Varsity Soccer Team made history
28 on Friday, February 25, 2022, when they upset top-seeded Miami Lourdes
29 1-0 to win the Florida High School Athletic Association Class 6A
30 girls soccer championship at Spec Martin Stadium in DeLand; and

31 **WHEREAS**, the Senators Girls' Varsity Soccer Team is comprised
