WHEREAS, Jacksonville PAL annually serves more than four thousand young people with year-round sports programs, after-school academic and recreational programs throughout the city, and summer camp opportunities at PAL's four permanent facilities; and

30 WHEREAS, PAL has touched the lives of hundreds of thousands of 31 Jacksonville's youths during its 50 years of outstanding service, and has been an invaluable resource by providing a safe environment for our youth and offering constructive alternatives to the temptations of challenged communities; now therefore
