WHEREAS, Timothy Middlebrooks, a Jacksonville native, graduated from William Raines High School in 2021; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Middlebrooks, following in his step-father's footsteps, joined the International Longshoremen's Association and took a job with a company loading and unloading ships at the Port of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, tragically, Timothy Middlebrooks was killed on the job in a warehouse accident less than one year into his working life; and WHEREAS, the unfortunate death of Mr. Middlebrooks at such a young age demonstrates the dangers inherent in the job of stevedoring and the need for constant vigilance and a safety focus in the workplace; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to extend its condolences to the young man's family; now therefore

The City Council hereby mourns the tragic passing of longshoreman Timothy Middlebrooks in an industrial accident and extends to the young man's family and friends the City's most sincere condolences.
