WHEREAS, the Council supports support Ukraine's independence, sovereignty and territorial integrity and stand by the people of Ukraine and its democratically elected institutions and representatives, and we support the Ukrainian people's right to live in peace and determine their own future; now therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

22 Section 1. The City of Jacksonville hereby extends support 23 to the people of Ukraine in this time of war and stands in solidarity 24 with the members of the Ukrainian population who have chosen to make 25 Jacksonville their home.

26 Section 2. Requesting emergency passage upon introduction 27 pursuant to Council Rule 4.901. Emergency passage upon introduction 28 of this Resolution is requested due to the volatile and unpredictable 29 war time conditions in Ukraine.
