ORDINANCE 2022-48-E

AN ORDINANCE ADOPTING THE 2021B SERIES TEXT AMENDMENT TO THE FUTURE LAND USE ELEMENT OF THE 2030 COMPREHENSIVE PLAN OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE, CREATING A NEW FUTURE LAND USE (FLUE) POLICY 3.1.27 TO ALLOW ELEMENT FOR CONSIDERATION TO AMEND LAND USE AND ZONING OF LEGAL LOTS OF RECORD EXISTING BEFORE SEPTEMBER 21, 1990, TO PERMIT DEVELOPMENT OF ONE SINGLE-FAMILY DWELLING PER LOT, SUBJECT TO CASE-BY-CASE REVIEW FOR CONSISTENCY WITH THE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

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WHEREAS, Council Member Diamond, as Chair of the Land Use and 18 19 Zoning Committee, has initiated certain revisions and modifications 20 to the text of the 2030 Comprehensive Plan in accordance with the 21 procedures and requirements set forth in Chapter 650, Part 4, 22 Ordinance Code, to facilitate the appropriate and timely 23 implementation of the plan, and has provided the necessary supporting 24 data and analysis to support and justify the amendments determined 25 to be required, and accordingly, has proposed certain revisions and 26 modifications, which are more particularly set forth in Exhibit 1, dated January 4, 2022, attached hereto and incorporated herein by 27 2.8 reference; and

WHEREAS, the City, by the adoption of Ordinance 2021-543-E, approved this amendment to the *2030 Comprehensive Plan* for transmittal to the Florida Department of Economic Opportunity (DEO), as the State Land Planning Agency, and other required state agencies, for review
and comment; and

3 WHEREAS, by various letters and e-mails, the DEO and other state 4 reviewing agencies transmitted their comments, if any, regarding this 5 proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

6 WHEREAS, the Planning and Development Department reviewed the 7 proposed revisions, considered all comments received, prepared a 8 written report and rendered an advisory recommendation to the Council 9 with respect to this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive 10 Plan; and

11 WHEREAS, the Planning Commission, as the Local Planning Agency, 12 held a public hearing on this proposed amendment to the 2030 13 Comprehensive Plan, with due public notice having been provided, and 14 reviewed and considered all comments received during the public 15 hearing, and made a recommendation to the City Council; and

16 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 650.408 Ordinance Code, the Land 17 Use and Zoning Committee held a public hearing in accordance with the 18 requirements of Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, on this proposed 19 amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, and has made its 20 recommendation to the City Council; and

21 WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 163.3184(3), Florida Statutes, and 22 Chapter 650, Part 4, Ordinance Code, the City Council held a public 23 hearing, with public notice having been provided, on this proposed 24 amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan; and

WHEREAS, the City Council further considered all oral and written comments received during the public hearings, including the data collection and analysis portions of this proposed amendment to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan, the recommendations of the Planning and Development Department and the Planning Commission, the final recommendations of the Land Use and Zoning Committee, and the comments, if any, of the DEO and the other state agencies; and

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WHEREAS, in the exercise of its authority, the City Council has 1 2 determined it necessary and desirable to adopt this proposed amendment 3 to the 2030 Comprehensive Plan to preserve and enhance present 4 advantages, encourage the most appropriate use of land, water and 5 resources, consistent with public interest, overcome present 6 deficiencies, and deal effectively with future problems that may 7 result from the use and development of land within the City of Jacksonville; now, therefore 8

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BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

10 Section 1. Purpose and Intent. This Ordinance is adopted to carry out the purpose and intent of, and exercise the authority 11 12 set out in, the Local Government Comprehensive Planning and Land 13 Development Regulation Act, Sections 163.3161 through 163.3248, 14 Florida Statutes, and Chapter 166, Florida Statutes, as amended. The amendment modifies the Future Land Use Element (FLUE) of the 2030 15 16 Comprehensive Plan of the City of Jacksonville, to create a new FLUE 17 Policy 3.1.27 to allow for consideration to amend the land use and 18 zoning of legal lots of record existing before September 21, 1990, 19 to permit development of one single-family dwelling per lot regardless 20 of the availability of centralized water or sewer facility connections 21 and related density or lot area requirements, subject to case-by-case 22 review for consistency with the Comprehensive Plan.

23 Section 2. Amendment to Comprehensive Plan. The 2030 24 Comprehensive Plan is hereby amended to include the revisions to the 25 text of the Future Land Use Element from the 2021B Series, which has 26 been initiated by Council Member Diamond as Chair of the Land Use and 27 Zoning Committee, as more particularly set forth in **Exhibit 1**, dated 28 January 4, 2022, attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference. 29 Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become Section 3. effective upon the signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective 30 31 without the Mayor's signature.
