## RESOLUTION 2022-130-A

RESOLUTION AND Α HONORING COMMENDING JACKSONVILLE JAGUARS GREAT TONY BOSELLI ON THE HONOR OF BEING ELECTED TO THE PRO FOOTBALL HALL OF FAME AND FOR HIS OUTSTANDING CONTRIBUTIONS TO JACKSONVILLE COMMUNITY; PROVIDING THE AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Tony Boselli, a native of Modesto, California, graduated from Fairview High School in Boulder, Colorado and earned a football scholarship to the University of Southern California, where he was a first-team All-Pac 10 and first-team All-American selection after the 1992, 1993 and 1994 seasons as a dominating offensive tackle; and

WHEREAS, in the spring of 1995 Mr. Boselli was the second selection in the NFL Draft and the first-ever draft choice of the brand-new Jacksonville Jaguars franchise, serving as the foundation on which the team's success was to be built. He met those expectations completely, proving to be one of the best linemen of his era and being voted to five consecutive Pro Bowls (1997-2001), a first-team All-Pro selection from 1997 through 1999, and voted as a member of the NFL's All-Decade Team for the 1990s. He was the first Jaquar enshrined in the team's Ring of Honor in 2006; and

WHEREAS, following an unfortunately early retirement after only 7 seasons due to a serious shoulder injury, Tony Boselli embarked on a varied and successful business career, owning bedding stores,

restaurants, and a marketing and advertising firm in partnerships with several of his former teammates and becoming a respected football broadcaster for the Fox network, Westwood One, and currently as a color commentator on the Jaguars' radio broadcast team; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his business interests, Mr. Boselli has been heavily involved in work with and on behalf of young people in the city. He and his wife Angi created the Boselli Foundation when they first arrived in Jacksonville to work with at-risk youth and help them to cultivate high self-esteem and to succeed at home, at school and at play. He has also been an assistant football coach at Episcopal High School with former Jaguars quarterback great Mark Brunell; and

WHEREAS, Tony Boselli's impact on the game of football was recently recognized with his election to the Pro Football Hall of Fame, the ultimate recognition for an NFL player, where he will be enshrined with the legends of the game; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The City Council hereby honors and commends Jacksonville Jaguar great Tony Boselli on his election to the Pro Football Hall of Fame and congratulates him on this outstanding recognition of his incomparable football career. The Council also commends and thanks Mr. Boselli for his outstanding work on behalf of young people in Jacksonville and his dedication to the well-being of the Jacksonville community.
