5 AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING \$249,938, INCLUDING  
6 \$187,453.50 IN GRANT FUNDING FROM THE FEDERAL  
7 EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY ("FEMA"), THROUGH  
8 THE STATE OF FLORIDA DIVISION OF EMERGENCY  
9 MANAGEMENT UNDER THE FEMA HAZARD MITIGATION  
10 GRANT PROGRAM, AND \$62,484.50 FROM GENERAL FUND  
11 OPERATING RESERVES FOR THE REQUIRED 25% CITY  
12 MATCH, TO BE USED FOR INSTALLATION OF WIND  
13 RESISTANT BAY DOORS AND HURRICANE SHUTTERS AT  
14 THE COUNTY PORT SECURITY DISASTER WAREHOUSE (THE  
15 "PROJECT"), AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-057; PURPOSE  
16 OF APPROPRIATION; AMENDING THE 2022-2026 FIVE-  
17 YEAR CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PLAN APPROVED BY  
18 ORDINANCE 2021-505-E TO REFLECT THIS  
19 APPROPRIATION FOR THE PROJECT; PROVIDING FOR  
20 OVERSIGHT BY THE JACKSONVILLE FIRE AND RESCUE  
21 DEPARTMENT, EMERGENCY PREPAREDNESS DIVISION;  
22 PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.  
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24 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

25 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,  
26 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated  
27 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)  
28 listed in subsection (b):

(c) Explanation of Appropriation:

The funding above represents an appropriation of a \$249,938 grant from the Federal Emergency Management Agency, distributed by the Florida Department of Emergency Management, and an appropriation of \$62,484.50 in General Fund Operating Reserves for the required 25% City match, for installation of wind resistant bay doors and hurricane shutters at the County Port Security Disaster Warehouse. The grant period commences upon execution of the Federally-Funded Subaward and Grant Agreement by both parties and continues through February 29, 2024.

**Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in Section 1 is to fund the installation of code compliant wind resistant bay doors and hurricane shutters at the County Port Security Disaster Warehouse (one warehouse building) located at 909 Haines Street, Jacksonville, Florida 32206 (the "Project"). These new bay doors and hurricane-rated shutters will meet the wind speed requirements in the area to prevent wind damage to this facility. All materials utilized will provide protection against 146 mile per hour winds or the wind speed protection and impact requirements of the Florida Building Code at the time the permits are issued. A copy of the Federally-Funded Subaward Grant Agreement (Agreement Number: H0795) providing the terms and conditions relative to receipt and expenditure of the grant funds has been placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services.

**Section 3. Capital Improvement Plan Amendment.** Ordinance 2021-505-E, adopting the 2022-2026 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan (the "CIP") for the City and certain of its independent agencies, is hereby amended to provide additional funding for completion of the

2 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** and incorporated herein by this  
3 reference. The City Council finds that the deferral of this amendment  
4 of the CIP until the next annual budget and CIP review will be  
5 detrimental to the best interests of the community because such  
6 deferral will unnecessarily delay the urgent need to wind retrofit  
7 the Disaster Warehouse with compliant bay doors and shutters prior  
8 to expiration of the grant.

9 Pursuant to Section 122.605(c), *Ordinance Code*, enactment of  
10 this Ordinance requires the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
11 City Council members present at the meeting because of the CIP  
12 amendment set forth in this section. This Ordinance shall constitute  
13 an amendment to Ordinance 2021-505-E. In all other respects, the  
14 Five-Year Capital Improvement Plan approved by Ordinance 2021-505-E  
15 shall remain unchanged and continue in full force and effect.

16 **Section 4. Oversight.** The Jacksonville Fire and Rescue  
17 Department, Emergency Preparedness Division shall oversee the Project  
18 and administration of the grant described herein.

19 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become  
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective  
21 without the Mayor's signature.
