Please provide the Public Works Real Estate Division with the authorization to request the legislation necessary for the Mayor to execute a Sovereignty Submerged Lands Lease, BOT No. 160359172, from the Board of Trustees of the Internal Improvement Trust Fund of the State of Florida, in substantially the same form as the attached. The purpose of this lease is for a new 10,065 square foot docking facility on the Saint Johns River in the Mayport Community. The docking facility will support the OCEARCH vessel at Jacksonville University, commercial fisherman, a research vessel, and other local charter fishing and recreation boating (upland parcels being RE#'s: 168955-0000, 168956-0000, 168957-0000, and 168958-0000). See maps attached. The lease will include an initial annual lease fee of \$4,960.10, with a 25% surcharge, plus sales tax will be charged with annual adjustments according to Section 212.031, Florida Statutes, and paragraphs 2 and 3 of the lease. The lease will terminate September 20, 2031.
