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ORDINANCE 2021-885-W

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND THE CORPORATION SECRETARY TO PURSUE OR SEEK WAIVER OF COLLECTION OF THE LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX WITHIN THE 2021-2022 BUDGET YEAR CONSISTENT WITH A PERIOD OF TIME TO ALIGN WITH THE STATE SUSPENSION OF THE STATE GAS TAX COLLECTION SHOULD THE STATE ALLOW FOR WAIVER OF THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 336.025 AND 336.021, FLORIDA STATUTES, SO THAT LOCAL HAVE THE ABILITY TO GOVERNMENTS SUSPEND COLLECTION OF LOCAL OPTION GAS TAXES; OFFERING FINDINGS AND STATEMENTS OF FACT; DIRECTING LEGISLATIVE SERVICES DIVISION TO FORWARD TO THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE, THE DUVAL LEGISLATIVE DELEGATION, AND THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, in May 2021, the City Council approved an extension to the current six-cent local option gas tax and levied a new five-cent local option gas tax and a one-cent local option gas tax (with the new five-cent and one-cent taxes together referred to herein as the "LOGT") in Ordinance 2021-223-E; and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of implementing the additional LOGT and executing interlocal agreements with the municipal corporations within Duval County to begin collection and disbursement of the LOGT on January 1, 2022; and

WHEREAS, in recent months following economic conditions related

to the COVID-19 pandemic and supply chain issues affecting the sale and delivery of products nationally and internationally, the price of gasoline at the pump has increased in a short period of time; and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Florida recently announced that he would propose to temporarily reduce the 26.5-cent per gallon state gas tax imposed pursuant to Chapter 336, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the suspension of the state gas tax does not negate collection of other gas taxes, including the federal gas taxes imposed at 18.4 cents a gallon and the LOGT totaling 12 cents per gallon (of which 6-cents for LOGT were approved in Ordinance 2021-223-E); and

WHEREAS, if the State temporarily suspends the state gas tax and creates a mechanism for local governments to waive the provisions of Sections 336.025 (pertaining to the 5-cent tax) and 336.021 (pertaining to the 9th cent tax), Florida Statutes, for the collection of local option gas taxes, the Council has indicated a desire to also initiate the process to temporarily suspend the collection of the LOGT; and

WHEREAS, the Council finds that it is a legitimate public purpose for the City of Jacksonville to suspend the 6-cent LOGT for a period of time consistent with the State's suspension of the state gas tax to alleviate some of the hardship that rising gas prices have taken on the citizens of Jacksonville; and

WHEREAS, in the interest of time, the Council desires to immediately authorize the City of Jacksonville to take initial action to temporarily suspend LOGT collection if the State takes action to suspend the state gas tax and authorizes local governments to waive provisions of Sections 336.025 and 336.021, Florida Statutes, and suspend collection of local option gas taxes; now therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings and Statement of Intent.

(a) The above recitals are hereby adopted as the Council's

Findings of Fact; and

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(b) It is the intent of Council, if authorized by the State, to take immediate action to waive provisions of Florida Statutes and align suspension of the LOGT with any State action that suspends collection of the state gas tax.

Section 2. Approval and Authorization to Mayor and City Administration to seek or pursue waiver of collection of LOGT during the 2021-2022 fiscal year for a period of time consistent with State suspension of state gas taxes to the temporary suspension of the LOGT if State allows local governments to suspend collection of local option gas taxes. During the 2021-2022 fiscal year, should the State suspend collection of state gas taxes and provide a mechanism for local governments to waive the provisions of Section 336.025 and 336.021, Florida Statutes, to suspend collection of the LOGT, the Mayor, or his designees within the Administration, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to pursue or seek waiver of collection of the LOGT for a period of time consistent with the suspension of collection of state gas taxes. Subsequent emergency legislation will be filed to authorize execution of documents related to such action and to authorize the appropriation of funding, if necessary, to prevent any lapses in funding from budgeted LOGT fund sources.

Section 3. Directing Legislative Services Division to Forward to the State Governor and Legislature, the Duval Legislative Delegation, and the Florida Department of Revenue. The Legislative Services Division is directed to send an electronic copy of this Ordinance upon enactment to the Governor, the Senate President and the Speaker of the House of the Florida Legislature, the members of the Duval Legislative Delegation, and the Florida Department of Revenue.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective

without the Mayor's signature.
