7 A RESOLUTION COMMENDING THE DUNCAN U. FLETCHER
8 HIGH SCHOOL GIRLS' VARSITY SOCCER TEAM FOR THEIR
9 OUTSTANDING SEASON AND UPON THEIR VICTORY IN THE
10 FLORIDA HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION CLASS
11 6A STATE CHAMPIONSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE
12 DATE.

14 **WHEREAS**, the Fletcher Senators Girls' Varsity Soccer Team has
15 not played in a state soccer semifinal since 2002, and their 1998
16 appearance was their only previous trip to the final; and

17 **WHEREAS**, the Lady Senators overcame multiple challenges on their
18 path to this year's state championship, including road victories at
19 Gainesville Buchholz High School, Navarre High School and Fleming
20 Island High School, and a state semifinal win against Viera High
21 School that required a rare direct corner kick goal to finally bring
22 home the trophy; and

23 **WHEREAS**, the team fought their way through the last month to go
24 on to encounter perhaps the biggest obstacle of the postseason, their
25 Miami opponents, Our Lady of Lourdes Academy. Lourdes previously won
26 the state championships in 2018 and 2020, and reached the state finals
27 in 2013, 2016 and 2021; and

28 **WHEREAS**, the Senators Girls' Varsity Soccer Team made history
29 on Friday, February 25, 2022, when they upset top-seeded Miami Lourdes
30 1-0 to win the Florida High School Athletic Association Class 6A
31 girls soccer championship at Spec Martin Stadium in DeLand; and

17 County Public School.
