Bill Summary: The bill declares surplus, closes and abandons the opened and improved right-of-way of Pearce Street in the Mid-Westside area of Council District 8 and conveys it to the Greater Friendly Missionary Baptist Church, Inc., subject to reservation of a JEA all-utilities easement and an AT&T utility easement.

Background Information: The right-of-way is a street dead end (approximately 120 feet long) between 19th Street and a CSX rail line. The Greater Friendly Missionary Baptist Church, located a block north of the street end, is requesting the closure in order to create a paved parking lot for the church and a running track for the neighborhood's use. Utility easements are reserved for JEA and AT&T use of the property.

Policy Impact Area: Surplus property disposition

Fiscal Impact: The Applicant has paid the right-of-way closure application fee of 6 \$2,091.
