Bill Summary: This legislation appropriates \$35,000 in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission for reimbursement of the City of Jacksonville's costs to remove and dispose of two derelict vessels located in public waterways. Removal of these derelict vessels will benefit the State of Florida, its resources, wildlife, public welfare, boater safety and help restore sensitive marine resources and improve water quality.

Background Information: Contract 21226 provides for the removal of a white 38' Bayliner Cabin Cruiser, located at 2852 Broward Road, and a white 29' Ericson Sailboat, located at ICW Channel Marker 34. Once removed, the vessels will be taken to an authorized landfill for disposal.

Policy Impact Area: Removal of derelict vessels
