Bill Summary: This bill confirms the Mayor's appointment of Linzee Ott as a member of the Downtown Development Review Board, as a full-time employee at a business located within the downtown area representative, replacing Brenna M. Durden for a first full term ending June 30, 2023.

Background Information: The Downtown Development Review Board is established pursuant to Section 656.361.7, *Ordinance Code*, and charged to review and make decisions with respect to all applications for development and redevelopment within the Downtown Overlay Zone. The nine voting members of the board are appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council, in various categories including a contractor, developer or realtor who does work within the downtown area.

Ms. Ott is currently the Community Engagement Coordinator for the Office for the State Attorney, 4th Judicial Circuit. Ms. Ott has a Bachelor of Arts degree in International Affairs and Political Science from Florida State University. Ms. Ott resides in Duval County.
