## RESOLUTION 2022-174-A

A RESOLUTION CONCERNING THE INTENTION OF THE TOURIST DEVELOPMENT COUNCIL ("TDC") TO INVOKE OF THE EXCEPTION SECTION 126.107(G) (GENERAL REGULATIONS), (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 CHAPTER 126, (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, TO DIRECT CONTRACT WITH JACKSONVILLE & THE BEACHES CONVENTION AND VISITORS BUREAU, INC., BUSINESS AS "VISIT JACKSONVILLE"; DOING PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, Visit Jacksonville has provided certain tourist bureau information, marketing, and convention services to the City of Jacksonville for over twenty (20) years; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jacksonville, through the TDC, and Visit Jacksonville are currently parties to three separate contracts regarding the provisions of tourist bureau information services, marketing, and convention services, each of which expires September 30, 2022, though each is subject to at least one renewal term at the City's discretion (the

"Contracts"); and

WHEREAS, TDC has identified Visit Jacksonville, by virtue of its employees, leadership and experience, as uniquely and strongly positioned to serve the tourism interests of the City of Jacksonville for the foreseeable future; and

WHEREAS, TDC desires to cement an extended relationship with Visit Jacksonville to provide stability to the parties as they implement a long-term tourism strategy that benefits the City of

Jacksonville and its citizens; and

WHEREAS, in lieu of preparing an RFP to solicit tourism bureau information, marketing, and convention services in connection with the potential expiration of the Contracts, TDC desires to file legislation invoking the exception of Section 126.107(g) (Procurement Code) and direct contract with Visit Jacksonville for a term of not less than ten (10) years, with at least one ten (10) year renewal term, subject to the City's ability to terminate the contract at any time for convenience; and

WHEREAS, at its meeting held on February 24, 2022, TDC unanimously approved direct contracting with Visit Jacksonville; now therefore

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. The Council has deliberated and debated the merits of permitting TDC to direct contract with Visit Jacksonville in the manner discussed above.

Section 2. The Council encourages TDC to submit formal legislation waiving Section 118.107, Ordinance Code, invoking the exception of Section 126.107 and authorizing TDC to direct contract with Visit Jacksonville on substantially the same terms as set forth herein.

Section 3. Effective Date. This resolution shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
