Bill Summary: This bill is an appropriation of \$128,160 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund for a donation to I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc., and various transfers of Fund dollars to other City funds in accordance with the *Ordinance Code* and Section 932.7055, *Florida Statutes*. The bill authorizes the Miscellaneous Appropriations Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. Section 110.112 (Advance of City funds; prohibition against), Part 1 (The City Treasury), Chapter 110 (City Treasury), *Ordinance Code*, is waived to allow advance payment. The Jacksonville Sheriff's Office will provide oversight.

Background Information: The purpose of this legislation is to provide funds for a donation to I.M. Sulzbacher Center for the Homeless, Inc. in the amount of \$42,000 for the Chronically Homeless Offender Program. This allocation supports programs and services aimed at drug treatment, drug abuse education, drug prevention, crime prevention, safe neighborhood, and/or school resource officer programs. This appropriation includes a transfer of \$12,500 from the Fund to the Teen Driver Special Revenue Fund for the Teen Driver Challenge Program in accordance with Section 111.365, *Ordinance Code*, a transfer of \$7,500 from the Fund to the Police Explorers Trust Fund for the Jacksonville Sheriff's Office Police Explorer Post, in accordance with Section 111.340, *Ordinance Code*, 11 and \$66,160 from the Fund to reimburse the General Fund for forfeiture-related expenditures in accordance with Section 932.7055(4)(c), *Florida Statutes*.

Fiscal Impact: Appropriation of \$128,160 from the Special Law Enforcement Trust Fund as initiated by B.T. 22-061; no local match or additional staffing obligations
