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ORDINANCE 2022-320

AN ORDINANCE MAKING CERTAIN FINDINGS AND APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER THE LICENSE AGREEMENT ("LICENSE") BETWEEN THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE AND THE GIVING CLOSET PROJECT, INC. ("LICENSEE") AUTHORIZING LICENSEE TO OCCUPY AND USE APPROXIMATELY 648 SQUARE FEET OF SPACE WITHIN THE KIDS HOPE ALLIANCE ("KHA") BUILDING, LOCATED AT 1095 A. PHILIP RANDOLPH BLVD., JACKSONVILLE, FLORIDA 32206, AT NO COST TO LICENSEE; PROVIDING FURTHER AUTHORIZATIONS; PROVIDING FOR OVERSIGHT BY KHA; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Findings. It is hereby ascertained, determined, found, and declared as follows:

- (a) The authorizations provided by this Ordinance are for public uses and purposes for which the City may use its powers as a county, municipality and as a political subdivision of the State of Florida to expend public funds, and the necessity in the public interest for the provisions herein enacted is hereby declared as a matter of legislative determination.
- Agreement. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, for and on behalf of the City of Jacksonville, the License

Agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Giving Closet Project, Inc. ("Licensee"), authorizing Licensee to use and occupy approximately 648 square feet of space, comprised of Classroom 104 and Meeting Research Room 106, in the Kids Hope Alliance building located at 1095 A. Philip Randolph Blvd., Jacksonville, Florida 32206, in substantially the same form attached hereto as **Exhibit 1** and incorporated herein by this reference. The License authorizes the Licensee's use and occupation of the licensed area within KHA's building, at no cost to Licensee, as office space to support Licensee's provision of basic necessities for KHA providers who are serving low-income and homeless youth. The License provides for an initial term commencing on May 1, 2022, and terminating on the earlier of: (i) June 30, 2024, or (ii) the earlier termination of the License in accordance with its terms.

Section 3. Further authorizations. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute amendments to the License that extend the License term for a period of up to six (6) months. The Mayor, or his designee, and the Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute all other contracts and documents and otherwise take all necessary action therewith and herewith, subject to review and approval by the Office of General Counsel, to effectuate the purpose and intent of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Oversight Department. Kids Hope Alliance will be responsible for oversight of the License on behalf of the City.

Section 5. Effective Date. This Ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
