## ORDINANCE 2022-321

AN ORDINANCE APPROVING, AND AUTHORIZING THE OR HIS DESIGNEE, AND CORPORATION SECRETARY TO EXECUTE AND DELIVER, THE FACILITIES MANAGEMENT CONTRACT BETWEEN SMG ("SMG"), A SUBSIDIARY OF ASM GLOBAL, INC., AND THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE (CITY), THE INITIAL TERM OF WHICH SHALL RUN FROM OCTOBER 1, 2022, THROUGH SEPTEMBER 30, 2027, WITH THE CITY HAVING THE UNILATERAL OPTION TO EXTEND THE CONTRACT ON THE SAME TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR ONE (1) FIVE-YEAR RENEWAL PERIOD; PROVIDING FOR TERMINATION OF THE CURRENT FACILITIES MANAGEMENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN SMG AND THE CITY; INVOKING THE EXCEPTION OF 126.107(G) (EXEMPTIONS), PART 1 (GENERAL REGULATIONS), CHAPTER 126 (PROCUREMENT CODE), ORDINANCE CODE, FOR DIRECT CONTRACT FOR PROGRAM SERVICES AND MANAGEMENT SERVICES WITH PROVIDING FOR CITY OVERSIGHT BY THE SPORTS & ENTERTAINMENT OFFICE; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

Section 1. Facilities Management Contract approved and execution authorized. There is hereby approved, and the Mayor, or his designee, and Corporation Secretary are hereby authorized to execute and deliver, the Facilities Management Contract between SMG and the City of Jacksonville (City), in substantially the same form placed **On File** with the Office of Legislative Services (the "Contract"). The initial term of the Contract runs from October 1, 2022, through September 30, 2027. The City has the unilateral option to extend the Contract on the same terms and conditions for one (1) additional, consecutive five-year renewal period. The current agreement between SMG and the City for management of the facilities shall be terminated upon the Effective Date of the Contract.

Section 2. Invoking the exception in Sec. 126.107(g), Ordinance Code. The City is hereby authorized to procure both the program services and the management services of SMG. Pursuant to Section 126.107(g) (Exemptions), Part 1 (General Regulations), Chapter 126 (Procurement Code), Ordinance Code, such procurement is exempted from competitive solicitation because the supplies or services are to be provided by those specifically prescribed within authorizing legislation that appropriates the same. With the exception of the foregoing, all other provisions of Chapter 126, Ordinance Code, shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 3. Oversight. The Sports & Entertainment Office shall provide oversight of the Contract.

Section 4. Effective Date. This ordinance shall become effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective without the Mayor's signature.
