9 REQUESTING ONE CYCLE EMERGENCY PASSAGE;

13 **WHEREAS**, the Personnel Committee of the City Council convened
14 on April 19, 2022, for the purpose of selecting the Chief of
15 Legislative Services, as described in Section 11.104, *Ordinance Code*;

17 **WHEREAS**, the Personnel Committee recommended Merriane G. Lahmeur
18 to be considered for appointment by City Council as Chief of
19 Legislative Services; now therefore

20 **BE IT RESOLVED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

21 **Section 1. Appointment.** The City Council hereby appoints
22 Merriane G. Lahmeur to be the City Council's Chief of Legislative
23 Services, pursuant to Section 11.104, *Ordinance Code*, to perform the
24 duties and responsibilities, and to serve under the terms, all as set
25 forth in Chapter 11, *Ordinance Code*.

26 **Section 2. Requesting One Cycle Emergency Passage Pursuant**
27 **to Council Rule 4.901 Emergency.** One cycle emergency passage of this
28 legislation is requested. The nature of the emergency is that the
29 position is currently vacant. The Council would like to complete the
30 appointment process as soon as possible in order to have a smooth and
31 seamless transition.

1 **Section 3. Prospective Effective Date.** This resolution
2 shall become effective May 11, 2022.

3 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This resolution shall become
4 effective upon enactment by the Council.
