7 INSURED PROGRAMS RETAINED EARNINGS TO PAY
8 ADDITIONAL INSURANCE PREMIUM COSTS FOR AVIATION,
9 PROPERTY, CYBER LIABILITY, AND SPECIAL EVENT
10 INSURANCE COVERAGE, AS INITIATED BY REVISED B.T.
11 22-064; PURPOSE OF THE APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING
12 AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

14 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

15 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
16 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
17 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
18 listed in subsection (b):

27 The funding above comprises an appropriation of \$913,968.01
28 from Insured Programs Retained Earnings to pay additional
29 insurance premium costs.

30 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
31 Section 1 is to transfer \$913,968.01 from Insured Programs Retained

1 Earnings to pay additional premium costs for aviation, cyber
2 liability, special events, and property insurance. The additional
3 costs relative to special events coverage include obtaining insurance
4 for the Jax River Jams, the Jacksonville Jazz Festival, the Florida
5 Georgia Game, and Veterans Day Parade events. The property insurance
6 premium increased, in part, to include coverage for the Jacksonville
7 Pier which is under construction and expected to be completed by July
8 2022.

9 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
10 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
11 without the Mayor's signature.
