Bill Summary: This bill authorizes the license agreement between the City of Jacksonville and The Giving Closet Project, Inc. to use and occupy approximately 648 square feet of space, comprised of Classroom 104 and Meeting Research Room 106, in the Kids Hope Alliance building located at 1095 A. Philip Randolph Blvd., Jacksonville, Florida 32206. The License provides for an initial term commencing on May 1, 2022 and terminating on the earlier of: (i) June 30, 2024, or (ii) the earlier termination of the License in accordance with its terms. Kids Hope Alliance will provide oversight.

Background Information: The Giving Closet Project is a teacher-created nonprofit that started in 2016 with the mission to help K-12 students living in poverty in Northeast Florida by providing clothing, hygiene items and other basic essentials. This legislation will enable the nonprofit to use office space within KHA's building, at no cost, to support the provision of basic necessities for KHA providers who are serving low-income and homeless youth.
