6 FUNDING FROM THE FLORIDA FISH AND WILDLIFE
7 CONSERVATION COMMISSION (THE "FWC") FOR
8 REIMBURSEMENT OF THE CITY OF JACKSONVILLE'S
9 COSTS TO REMOVE AND DISPOSE OF TWO DERELICT
10 VESSELS LOCATED IN PUBLIC WATERWAYS IN THE CITY
11 OF JACKSONVILLE, AS INITIATED BY B.T. 22-054;
12 PURPOSE OF APPROPRIATION; PROVIDING FOR
13 OVERSIGHT BY THE NEIGHBORHOODS DEPARTMENT,
14 ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY DIVISION; PROVIDING AN
15 EFFECTIVE DATE.

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17 **BE IT ORDAINED** by the Council of the City of Jacksonville:

18 **Section 1. Appropriation.** For the 2021-2022 fiscal year,
19 within the City's budget, there are hereby appropriated the indicated
20 sum(s) from the account(s) listed in subsection (a) to the account(s)
21 listed in subsection (b):

28 (c) Explanation of Appropriation:

29 The funding above represents an appropriation of \$35,000.00
30 in grant funding from the Florida Fish and Wildlife
31 Conservation Commission (the "FWC") for reimbursement to

1 the City of the costs to remove and dispose of two derelict
2 vessels located in public waterways within the City.

3 **Section 2. Purpose.** The purpose of the appropriation in
4 Section 1 is to appropriate grant funding from the FWC to offset the
5 City's costs for removal and disposal of two derelict vessels located
6 in public waterways within the City. Pursuant to that certain State
7 of Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission Agreement No.
8 21226 (the "Agreement"), the FWC will reimburse the City up to
9 \$35,000.00 for removal of a white 38' Bayliner Cabin Cruiser located
10 at 2852 Broward Road and a white 29' Ericson Sailboat located at
11 Intracoastal Waterway Channel Marker 34. Removal of these vessels
12 must occur prior to expiration of Agreement on June 17, 2022. Both
13 vessels will be disposed of in an authorized landfill facility. A
14 copy of the Agreement is **On File** with the Office of Legislative
15 Services.

16 **Section 3. Oversight.** The Environmental Quality
17 Division of the Neighborhoods Department shall provide oversight of
18 the project described herein.

19 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Ordinance shall become
20 effective upon signature by the Mayor or upon becoming effective
21 without the Mayor's signature.
